What is a plastic attack?

A plastic attack is a polite and peaceful action for anyone concerned about the excessive use of plastic which damages our environment and costs taxpayers millions to dispose of. Its family friendly and all are welcome.

We turn up at our local supermarket as a group, invite others to join us, do our shopping and then unwrap our goods and hand the packaging back to the store manager. We've contacted the manager at Sainsbury's who is expecting us.

What should I bring?

You'll need plenty of **reusable bags** and **boxes** to empty your shopping into (it's surprising how many you'll need) and scissors are a good idea to help unwrap your shopping. Have a think in advance about what you need that can easily be unwrapped. A packet of pasta is way easier to empty than a bottle of milk, for example!

Why are we doing this?

Single-use plastic is choking our oceans and harming our environment. Most of it doesn't get recycled and cleaning it up costs UK taxpayers millions every year. It's almost impossible to do your shopping without encountering single use plastic - we're calling on supermarkets and manufacturers to quit their dependence on plastic.

Since communities began staging these protests, progress has been made but companies must move faster!
